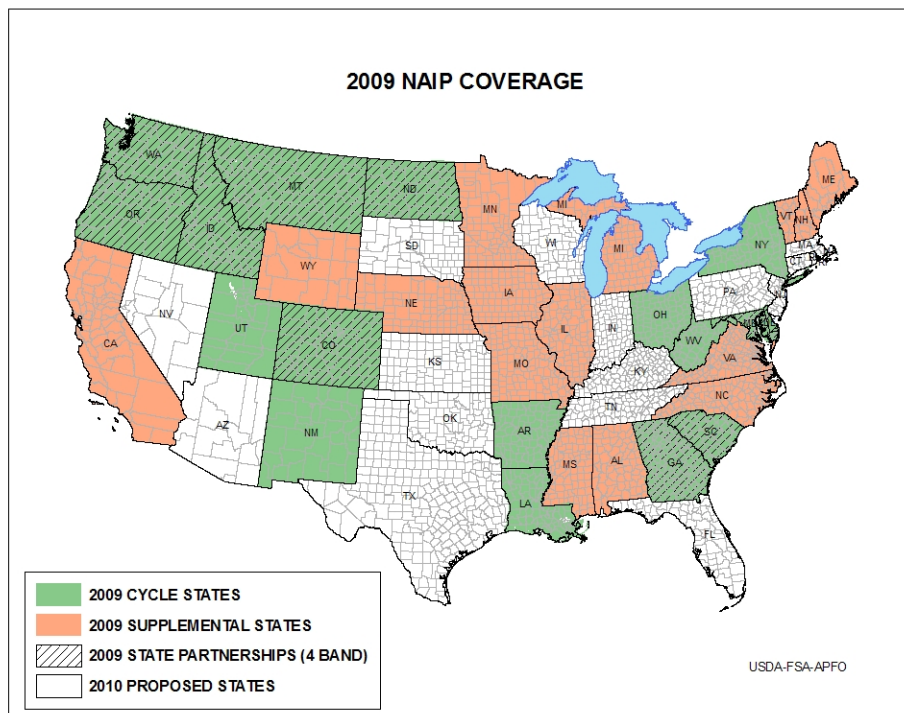
2009 NAIP – Supplemental Funding

2009 Supplemental

- On May 20, 2009 the Farm Service Agency (FSA) was instructed by Under Secretary of Agriculture Miller to allocate a total of \$24 million in funding for the 2009 NAIP acquisition. This amount, combined with cost share funding from partners at the federal and state level, resulted in an additional 15 states, bringing the total to 32 states for 2009. States to be acquired in 2009 are listed on the map below.
- Federal cost share partners in 2009 will receive copies of the NAIP deliverables for all states, including states acquired through supplemental funding.
- States acquired with supplemental funding will meet all NAIP specifications for 1 meter, 3-band, absolute accuracy, and seam line shape files.
- The late date of the contract task awards for the additional 15 states prevents any “buy ups” within the 2009 NAIP contract. However, contractors are acquiring the 4th band in most states which can be purchased directly from them at a later date

2010 Cost Share Partnerships

- States proposed for 2010 NAIP are the remaining 16 states not flown in 2009, indicated on the map below. With funding levels for 2010 NAIP uncertain, cost share partnerships are encouraged to help ensure coverage of states.
- For 2010 NAIP, minimum cost share amounts for partners at the federal level and for individual states are what were previously established for the 3 year NAIP cycle.
- Partnership buy ups for 2010 NAIP include a “4 Band” product.
