Design Comments:

Kewaunee, Manitowoc, and Sheboygan counties have the same projection system. The Sheboygan County projection was completed in December 1992 and was designed to fit the lake shore area and the general rise in elevation from east to west within Sheboygan County. This trend is true for Manitowoc and Kewaunee counties as well.
