The WISCORS (Wisconsin Continuously Operating Reference Station) Network is the Active Component of the Wisconsin Height Modernization Program.

The construction of the WISCORS Network was funded through federal and state funds. In order to service, update and replace system equipment, hardware, and software on an ongoing basis, the State Legislature has authorized the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) to charge a Systems Maintenance Fee (Wis. Stat. s. 85.63 Surveying Reference Station System). The Systems Maintenance Fee is expected to go into effect after the Rule has been completed in State FY17 (July 1, 2016 – June 30, 2017).
