

## **Wisconsin Statewide Parcel Data**



Wisconsin Act 20, the biennial state budget for 2013-2015, created statutory directives for state and local governments to coordinate on the development of a statewide digital parcel map. The Statewide Parcel Map Initiative is an effort to create a digital parcel database for Wisconsin by aggregating local parcel datasets utilizing GIS technology. The Parcel Initiative is a multi-faceted, multi-year collaborative effort between the Department of Administration, the State Cartographer's Office, and Wisconsin's local governments.


